CRICUT CREATIONS

Electronic die cutting machines can really make mass-producing cards and paper arts quick and easy. I will be showing you ways to use machines like the Cricut Impression (not the Imagine, Impression 2 or Craft Room) to make a variety of cards and 3D items come alive. All of the pieces will be pre-cut for you. The purpose of the class is to show you ways to highlight and layer die cuts, make backgrounds and mats, make labels and tags, make borders, edges and corners, add depth to your die cuts, cut a variety of different materials and much more. Also in the class I will show you ways to use these machines to mass-produce and store pre-made cuts for future use. I will have complete directions for you including the cartridge and keys to use to reproduce the projects later. You do not have to have an Impression to attend the class. You will be making cards, gift enclosures, small gift items and more. We will not be doing scrapbooking but the ideas could be use for layouts also. Note: The photo samples on the web site show SOME of the projects we will be making!
